

NAVAJO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' MINUTES
MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 10, 2012 AT 9:00 A.M.
EMERGENCY MEETING

PRESENT: J.R. DeSpain, Chairman was present in person. David Tenney, Supervisor; Jerry Brownlow, Supervisor; and Jesse Thompson, Supervisor were present telephonically. Jonathan M. Nez, Supervisor was not present. Treasurer Manny Hernandez, County Attorney Brad Carlyon and Recorder Laurie Justman were present.

At 9:02 a.m. **Chairman DeSpain** called the meeting to order.

ELECTIONS: Consideration and possible approval of the Official Amended Canvass of the Primary Election conducted on August 28, 2012: Johnathan Roes indicated that after the canvass on Friday, there was an error discovered. Mr. Roes asked that we comply with A.R.S. §16-645 and re-canvass the election. Supervisor Brownlow asked what the error was. Mr. Roes explained that there was a batch of ballots that had not been counted. He further explained that those ballots have now been counted, that the numbers have changed slightly however there were no changes in the outcomes of the results. **Supervisor Brownlow made a motion** to approve the official amended canvass of the primary election conducted on August 28, 2012; motion seconded by **Supervisor Tenney**. Vote unanimous approving the motion.
