Navajo County hereby informs the public that a member of the Navajo County Redistricting Advisory Committee, **Leonard Eltsosie**., will hold a meeting open to the public on **Wednesday, June 22, 2011**, for the purpose of seeking public input and comments regarding the County's redistricting of the Supervisorial Districts and Northland Pioneer Community College District precincts. The meeting will be held in **Hotevilla at the Youth & Elderly Center at 6:00 p.m.**

The Navajo County Board of Supervisors is required to redistrict every ten years after the release of the decennial census. For this reason, the Board of Supervisors has established a Redistricting Advisory Committee to seek out public input regarding where the new district lines should be drawn, and ultimately to make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors about a redistricting plan for the County. The input of the public is welcomed and strongly encouraged in these efforts.

The public meeting on **June 22** is one of two community meetings scheduled in **Hotevilla**, with the second scheduled to occur on **August 10**, at which time specific redistricting proposals will be presented to the public.
