



**NOTICE OF COMMUNITY MEETING RE:
NAVAJO COUNTY REDISTRICTING PROJECT
TUESDAY, JUNE 7, 2011**

Navajo County hereby informs the public that a member of the Navajo County Redistricting Advisory Committee, Robert Black Jr., will hold a meeting open to the public on **Tuesday, June 7, 2011**, for the purpose of seeking public input and comments regarding the County's redistricting of the Supervisorial Districts and Northland Pioneer Community College District precincts. The meeting will be held in Kayenta, Arizona at the Kayenta Justice Court at 6:00 p.m.

The Navajo County Board of Supervisors is required to redistrict every ten years after the release of the decennial census. For this reason, the Board of Supervisors has established a Redistricting Advisory Committee to seek out public input regarding where the new district lines should be drawn, and ultimately to make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors about a redistricting plan for the County. The input of the public is welcomed and strongly encouraged in these efforts.

The public meeting on June 7 is one of two community meetings scheduled in Kayenta, with the second scheduled to occur on August 2, 2011, at which time specific redistricting proposals will be presented to the public.
