Employee Responsibility

Immediately notify your supervisor if you have any of the following symptoms:

- Diarrhea
- Vomiting
- Jaundice
- Sore throat with fever
- Open wounds or sores



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Supervisor Responsibility

Exclude employees from establishment for:

- Diarrhea
- Vomiting
- Jaundice
- Sore Throat with Fever
- Having known contact with anyone diagnosed with a foodborne illness (Big Six).

Exclude employees diagnosed with a Foodborne Illness (Big Six):

- Salmonella Typhi
- Non-Typhoidal Salmonella
- Escherichia Coli
- Shigella
- Norovirus
- Hepatitis A

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), food handlers working while sick is a commonly associated factor in foodborne illness outbreaks. For this reason, permit holders are required to notify the Office of Environmental Health when an employee is diagnosed with a reportable (Big 6) foodborne illness.
